Personal Timeline Project Instruction and Rubric

Your name, dates, labeling, and any other wording or numbers on your timeline must be discernable from at least 3 feet away. All writing and numbering must be legible.

The drawings and symbols associated with your timeline must be discernable from at least 6 feet away.

1. Drawing and numbering the time line **(20 pts.)**

- a. Print your Last Name, then First Name in the upper left hand corner of the paper in letters that are approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ inch in height.
- b. Fold the paper "hotdog" making a crease in the vertical center of the paper
- c. Use a ruler and a number 2 pencil to make a dark uniform line along the fold.
- d. Using a ruler and pencil; move in $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from the left edge of the paper and make a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch vertical dash centered on the line created in step c. This will be the beginning of your time line.
- e. Using a ruler and pencil; from the beginning of your time line, make a short (approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ inch long) vertical dash mark every one inch along the line created in step c until you are $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from the right edge of your paper. When finished, you should have a total of 22 vertical dash marks including the beginning and ending marks. The first mark represents 22 B? with the ? representing the first letter of your first name. Each successive mark represents 2 years. Be sure to use a ruler and be precise. Also, be sure to use the inches edge of the ruler.
- f. Using a ruler and pencil; neatly, legibly, and in the appropriate proportional size, label each mark on the line from 22 B? to 20 placing the number just **below** the dash mark.

2. Label the dash mark that represents the year of your birth with the month, day, and year you were born. If you know the time of day you were born, include that as well. Also, label the dash mark with the name of the town and state where you were born. **(10 pts.)**

3. Label each of the dots placed on the time line. Each label must include: 1) the name of the event 2) the year it occurred (include the month and day if known) 3) As applicable, a description of the event. Labels must be legible and visible from 2-3 feet away. **(20 pts.)**

4. Draw and color graphic illustrations (drawings and/or symbols) associated with **5** timeline events of your choice. Illustrations must be visible and discernable from approximately 5 feet away. **(30 pts.)**

5. Designate and label the following eras on the Time Line. These labels must be legible and visible from at least 5 feet away. **(20 pts)**

- Infant
- Toddler
- Child
- Juvenile
- Young Adult
